Payments, Cancellations, and Refunds

If full payment has not been received and confirmed by TACAC by June 28, 2024, registrations may be canceled and attendees must re-register if space allows. All refunds are subject to a \$15 processing fee. No refunds will be processed for cancellations received after June 28, 2024 or for no-shows.

Arrival

Please arrive promptly on Monday, ready to check into your room and pick up your institute materials. You may want to use any time you have between checking in and the Welcome Session to set up your room. The institute will begin promptly with the Welcome Session at 2:45pm.

Directions and Parking

ACCI Conference and Housing Check In

Once you arrive you can check in at the Baldwin Hall (Trull Ln N, Kerrville, TX 78028). This is where you will register and receive your institute materials along with your housing assignment. To cut down on the amount of walking, you may bring your luggage with you when you check in as your housing assignment will be in Baldwin Hall.

If you are a commuter participant, you will follow the same procedure by checking in at Baldwin Hall between 12:00-2:00 PM.

Schedule and App

Download the TACAC app on the App Store or Google Play by searching for "TACAC". The app is where you will find the detailed schedule, bios of faculty members, and other important information you need throughout the week. It is also where you will find all of your materials for the week that you can download to your device to use during the institute.

Once you have downloaded the app, it should immediately take you to the ACCI page. If not, select the "More" option at the bottom of the screen, select events, and you should then see ACCI 2024. You should automatically be prompted to login, if not, click on the silhouette in the top right corner. This will allow you to access all of the content within the app including presentation slides and handouts. At this time, updates will be ongoing until the institute begins, so be sure to refresh each time you enter the app.

Housing

Resident participants will be staying in Baldwin Hall. Each participant will have their own bedroom and will share a suite with up to 3 other attendees of the same gender. Each suite will have two bathrooms. Please keep in mind that spouses, children and pets are not eligible to stay in the residence halls.

Also, please remember that these are college residence hall rooms that have minimal furnishings and no housekeeping. Linens will not be provided, so please bring a blanket, XL twin sheets, towels, and pillows from home.

Laundry facilities are available to participants at no cost, but please bring your own detergent should you need to do laundry. If you need additional toilet paper or would like to report a problem with your room, please contact the residence hall staff. You will find their contact information in the residence halls.

Participants arriving in Kerrville on Sunday, July 14 will need to make separate accommodations for the evening.

Residence Hall Packing List

Meals

All meals, with the exception of dinner on Wednesday, July 17 are covered by your registration fee and will be enjoyed in the Gus Schreiner Complex/Dining Hall. All participants will eat dinner on their own on Wednesday night, and a list of nearby options will be provided in the TACAC ACCI app.

Snacks and beverages will be provided during the day. Please bring a reusable water bottle as there will be a water refill station in our main meeting space.

Mock College Fair Materials

Higher Ed participants will host a Mock College Fair on Tuesday, July 16. If you are a Higher Ed participant, you should bring materials with you (packing list below), or ship materials in advance. There may be as many as 40 people coming by your table, so plan accordingly.
